





Graduation prize "Alberto Baratè / Rotary Club Lomellina"

Features of the prize and candidates

Every student of the School of Industrial and Information Engineering of Politecnico di Milano, who took the Final Exam and graduated between January 2020 and December 2021, is eligible for the "Alberto Baratè" graduation prize of € 1.000,00 (pre-tax), sponsored by Rotary Club Lomellina. The only requirement for the candidate is to have written a Master's Thesis on aluminium and its alloys, including one or more of the following topics:

- Extruded and rolled wrought products;
- · Packaging technologies and applications;
- Aluminium for structural applications;
- Innovative alloys and processes;
- Aluminium moulds and dies.

How to apply

Eligible candidates must submit their application by filling in a form, through which they must send the required documents: https://tinyurl.com/ska6f747.

The submission deadline is the 10th of January 2022 by no later than 12:00 pm (CET – UCT+1). Candidates must attach to their application the following documents:

- Presentation letter;
- Short cv;
- The pdf file of their Master's Thesis (max 20 MB);
- The pdf file of the Abstract of their Master's Thesis (max two pages).

Incomplete or inadequate submitted documents will result in immediate exclusion from the evaluation process. If the dissertation has more than one author, each graduate willing to participate must apply individually.

Evaluation Committee

The final ranking will be defined by a four-member Evaluation Committee made of two Professors of the Department of Mechanical Engineering, a representative of the Rotary Club Lomellina, and a representative of the company "Baratè S.p.a.". To define the ranking, the Committee will consider the applicant's academic path and Master's Thesis. In case of equal ranking, the Committee can divide the total amount of the prize among all winners. Moreover, the Committee can also decide not to allocate the prize.

The final ranking will be published on the website of the Mechanical Engineering Programme of Politecnico di Milano (www.mecheng.polimi.it). The candidates who ranked first, second and third will receive a certification with the logos of all involved institutions signed by the CEO of "Baratè S.p.A.", the Director of Studies of the Postgraduate Programme in Mechanical Engineering at Politecnico di Milano and the pro tempore president of the Rotary Club Lomellina.







General rules

Limitations: this graduation prize can not be allocated to a Master's Thesis that already won other graduation prizes.

Renounce: in case of the winner's withdrawal, the next candidate on the ranking automatically wins the prize.

Allocation: the prize is paid in full. The winners of the graduation prize will receive a notification via email at their polimi address after the publication of the final ranking. The winners must fill in, sign and send back the acceptance modules attached to the received email within ten days.

Taxation: in terms of taxes, the allocated prizes are subject to the law in force on scholarships and graduation prizes.

Failure to provide: if the prize is not allocated for any given reason, the same amount of money will be destined to the same graduation prize re-issued later in time.
